Illegal Dumping Enforcement Training

Will the polluter pay for the cleanup, or will the taxpayer?

The difference is serious local enforcement.

This class, hosted by Washington County and Brazos Valley Council of Governments, provides the participant with a comprehensive overview of the options available to local governments to fight illegal dumping and other forms of pollution. Here are the tools you need.

Topics covered include: Texas administrative enforcement by the TCEQ; local code enforcement; health authority enforcement (and law enforcement of health statutes); misdemeanor and felony criminal enforcement; local civil suits for violations of environmental statutes, rules, orders, and permits; trade-offs between the options; and, specific ways for paying for cleanups.

This is an ideal class for local code enforcement officers, registered sanitarians, peace officers, elected officials, specialized environmental enforcement officers, and staff needing a comprehensive understanding of their enforcement options in fighting illegal dumping.

Six law enforcement (TCLEOSE) or code enforcement/RS (DSHS) continuing education hours will be awarded, including one hour in "Legal / Legislative Updates" for code enforcement officers.

The fee for attending this class is \$55, which may be paid by check or credit card.
