

Housing Navigator: The Housing Navigator will be responsible for working to improve housing in the Brazos Valley for seniors and people living with disabilities as well as working as a resident repair care coordinator. The Housing Navigator will work with the Aging and Disability Resource Center (ADRC) and the Area Agency on Aging (AAA) to complete the duties of the Housing Navigator. The Housing Navigator will work with housing organizations, community coalitions and local governments to advocate for housing for seniors and people with disabilities leaving institutional settings or to individuals at risk of entering institutional settings. Duties include inventory of independent integrated, accessible and affordable housing in the Brazos Valley region; work with housing developers regarding accessible, affordable and integrated housing issues; identify and attend local coalition meetings, consisting of consumers and community members that will work toward affordable, assessable and integrated housing as well as advocate for necessary changes in housing policies, practices and procedures that will expand housing opportunities.

Bachelor's degree preferred with 1-2 years' experience in Social Services, housing or a related field. Basic office computer skills including word processing, presentation and database programs. Ability to communicate orally and in writing on a professional level. Exhibit good customer service skills, reliability and demonstrate capability of handling sensitive and confidential information.
